This short guide gives setup steps to get your PC or laptop ready for Qvidian use with Chrome or Microsoft Edge browsers. It also includes recommended Word settings. 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Browser Configuration - Allow Qvidian as Pop-up Block Exception

Qvidian is an application that opens new windows and dialog boxes. It is important that your browser allow pop-ups from the Qvidian site.

Chrome

- 1. Open Chrome.
- 2. In the upper right corner, click the Customize and Control Google Chrome button.



- 3. Click Settings.
- 4. Click Privacy and security.
- 5. Click Site Settings.

Microsoft Edge

- 1. Open Microsoft Edge.
- 2. In the upper right corner, click the Settings and more button.
- 3. Click Settings
- 4. Click Cookies and site permissions.
- 5. Scroll to Pop-up and redirects.



- 6. .Click Add next to Allow
- 7. Type [*.]Qvidian.com (Enter this as shown with the brackets.)
- 8. Click Add.

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Microsoft Word Configuration

The following Microsoft Word configurations are recommended for all computers on which users will access Qvidian. Qvidian is compatible with Microsoft Office 2019 and 365.

Microsoft Office Word 2019 and 365

- 1. Select the File tab in Word.
- 2. Click **Options**.
- 3. Click Trust Center.
- 4. Click Trust Center Settings.
- 5. Click Protected View.
 - Disable (uncheck) Enable Protected View for files originating from the Internet.
 - Disable (uncheck) Enable Protected View for files located in potentially unsafe locations.

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Activate your Qvidian Account.

When your user account is created, a Qvidian generated email with a link to create a password, security question and answer, is sent. If you did not receive the email message it may be blocked, or it may have gone into junk mail.

- 1. Click the link in the email.
- 2. Create a **password**.
- 3. Create a security question and answer.
- 4. Click Submit.

Once you have created your password, security question and answer, the Log in screen will be presented.

- 1. Enter your User Name and Password.
- 2. Check Remember me.
- 3. Check Bookmark the Qvidian URL.
